

Travelling to Sweden (valid for travelers who are not citizens/residents of Sweden)

This is a summary.

Entry from an EU/EEA¹ country, incl. the Nordics

No restrictions (do not need to show a Covid certificate; the Police does not check COVID-19 certificates at the border).

Entry from a non-EEA country

Must show a valid covid certificate

- and reside in an **exempted**² country or
- issued in an **approved**³ country.

1. EEA = Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia and Spain and the non EEA countries Switzerland, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino and the Vatican.

2. Travelers are allowed to enter Sweden if they can document **residence** in one of the **exempted countries** (not merely hold citizenship), and hold a **valid covid certificate**. The travelers must otherwise fulfill the entry given in the Schengen Border Code and the Visa Code.

Non-EEA and exempted = Bahrain, Chile, Colombia, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Kuwait, Macao, New Zealand, Peru, Qatar, Rwanda, Saudi Arabia, South Korea, Taiwan, United Arab Emirates (UAE), and Uruguay.

3. Fully vaccinated travelers holding vaccine certificates issued in one of the following so-called **approved countries**, at least 14 days before arrival and the vaccine being **EMA** or **WHO** approved, can enter Sweden without a negative test. Regular visa and passport requirements still apply.

Non-EEA and approved = Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Cabo Verde, El Salvador, Faroe Islands, Georgia, Israel, Lebanon, Morocco, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, New Zealand, North Macedonia, Panama, San Marino, Serbia, Singapore, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, Togo, Tunisia, Turkey, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates (UAE), the UK + Guernsey, Isle of Man and Jersey, Uruguay, the USA, and the Vatican.
